

# INTEGRATED ZERO TO ATPL

## INTEGRATED zero to ATPL frozen

**Olympus Aviation** has developed a thorough integrated pilot training program to bring the students up to the proficiency so that they operate as co-pilots on single and/or multi-engine airliners in commercial air transport and continue their career in aviation. The integrated training course is a full-time course from **zero hour experience** through to obtaining a **frozen EASA ATPL (f ATPL) with MCC certificate**.

When you choose to enroll for an integrated course you've decided to become a professional pilot attending a full time course, including **day-to-day** ground and flight training.

### Pre-Entry Requirements

- Be at least 17 years old,
- Fluent in **English**,
- Holder of a valid EASA Medical Certificate **Class 1\***.

*\*Medical Certificate can be obtained at Thessaloniki's Medical center.*

### Enrollment time

For Zero to ATPL all time around the year.

### Registration Process

Prior to the start of the course the student is required to complete the enrolment process by submitting the **ATPL Application** form accompanied by EASA **Medical Class 1** certificate, a copy of an **ID or Passport**, a copy of a High School **Diploma** (or equivalent).

### Course Duration

The minimum duration of the ATPL integrated course is 12 months. In **OLYMPUS Aviation** the average time required to complete the **ATPL** course is **12 – 14 months**, including Training and Exams. Regularly the flight training begins about **1** month after the start of the course and runs continuously from that point onwards.

### Theoretical Training

The **ATPL Theory** consists of **14** subjects and includes **750 hrs** of classroom training **OXFORD** GS approved inter-active video training, presentations, progress tests, sample exams and Final Progress tests. The duration of Ground School is **7** months. The student will complete the ATPL Theoretical Training after passing **OLYMPUS Aviation** Final progress tests with a grade equal or higher than **80%**. **EASA** min rate is equal or higher than **75%**.

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The flight training course consists of :

- A total of **206 hrs**, **133 hrs** of them are conducted on Single Engine Piston aircraft (**SEP/IR**)
- **13 hrs** on Multi Engine Piston aircraft (**MEP/IR**)
- **60 hrs** on **FNPT II** included **15 hrs MCC** F/S for Multi Crew Cooperation Course.
- (**APP**) **Air Line Preparation Program (18 hrs)**. The **new** graduated Pilots follow the new APP course which prepares them for 'Pilot Selection assessment' and general SOP's for an Airline Company.
- Optionally **Type rating on A-320 or B-737 NG**.

## Zero to ATPL Integrated course cost

- **0-ATPL Integrated course: 57.900,00 €** with full class of **750 hrs Ground school (R.C.)**
